INSTITUTE: Uganda Petroleum Institute Kigumba (UPIK)
TRAINING PERIOD: Eight (8) Months

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA – IVQ (Welding, Fabrication & Pipework)

- 1) Ugandans 18 years and above originating from Nwoya, Kiryandongo, Masindi, Buliisa, Kibaale, Kagadi, Hoima, Kikuube, Kakumiro, Kyankwanzi, Mubende, Gomba, Sembabule, Lwengo, Rakai and Kyotera districts.
- 2) Holders of O' level certificate/equivalent **OR** Holders of a National Vocational and Technical Crafts certificate in Welding and Metal fabrication **OR** Have at least 2 years of practice/experience in Welding and Metal fabrication.
- 3) Have basic English reading and writing skills, good mathematical and physics skills (basic knowledge in electricity).
- 4) Have good eyesight and be physically and medically fit.
- 5) Preference will be given to applicants previously trained in welding who have proof of their training/certification.

- 6) Participants must be able to commit to stay at the training institute for at least 8 Weeks and complete the training.
- 7) Female candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.
- 8) Applicant should present evidence that he/she comes from one of the districts mentioned above.
