



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR PROVISION OF ONSHORE 2D SEISMIC DATA ACQUISITION AND PROCESSING SERVICES FOR THE KASURUBAN CONTRACT AREA (KSCA) (Ref: UNOC/KSCA/SERVICE/2024/00016)

The Uganda National Oil Company Limited (UNOC) is a limited liability company wholly owned by the Government of Uganda. UNOC is mandated to handle the State's commercial aspects of petroleum activities and the participating interests of the State in the petroleum agreements.

UNOC is the operator of the Kasuruban Contract Area (KSCA), located in the Northern Lake Albert sub-basin, Albertine Graben, Uganda, and covers parts of the districts of Hoima, Buliisa and Masindi. The delivery of the 2024 Work Program is ongoing and among other activities is the acquisition and processing of 150-line kilometers of 2D seismic data.

Scope of Work:

The services have been split into two lots:

- **Lot 1:** Acquisition of 150-line kilometers of 2D seismic data onshore the Contract Area.
- **Lot 2:** Processing of the acquired (150-line kilometers) of 2D seismic data.

Bidders may indicate interest in any or both services stated in the scope of work.

Minimum requirements for pre-qualification

- Certificate of Registration/Incorporation or its equivalent.
- Tax Clearance Certificate or its equivalent for 2023.
- Current registration on or an application to be registered on the National Supplier Database (NSD) managed by the Petroleum Authority of Uganda.
- Evidence of Quality, Health, Safety and Environment (QHSE) compliance.
- Audited books of accounts for the last two (2) years.
- The selected bidder will be required to comply with applicable National Content Regulations.

The entity must have a proven track record of providing seismic data acquisition and/or processing services.

Interested companies that meet the above minimum requirements should submit their Expressions of Interest (EOI), together with a Certificate of incorporation by email to pl.unoc@unoc.co.ug not later than 10:00 hours East African Time (EAT) (Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) +3) **Friday 2nd August 2024**. A pre-qualification questionnaire will be issued to the interested entities upon receipt of their EOI. Request for Proposals will be issued to entities that successfully pass the pre-qualification stage.
