3. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the ***Open Domestic Bidding*** method contained in the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act Cap 205 and is open to all bidders.

Bidders should

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security for the different Lots using the form indicated in the bidding forms. The Bid Security must be valid until **9th June 2026**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids shall be virtually opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend the online/virtual public bid opening session via Microsoft Teams Platform at **10:40am** on **19th January 2026**. Bidders will be required to share email addresses of their representatives to attend the online/virtual public bid opening session prior to submission of Bids.

All interested eligible bidders are advised to include their email addresses in the Application letter (in 5 above) which UNOC will use to contact and invite them for the virtual online meeting.
