INVITATION TO BID FOR PROVISION OF AN INTEGRATED ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING (ERP) SYSTEM: UNOC/NCONS/25-26/00280.

1. Uganda National Oil Company Limited (UNOC) has allocated funds to be used for the Provision, Installation, Training, Commissioning and Maintenance of an Integrated Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) System as indicated in the table below;

3. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the ***Open International Bidding*** method contained in the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act Cap 205 and is open to all bidders.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bidding document at the address given below at 8(a) from **8:00am** to **5:00pm**.
5. The Bidding document in English may be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written application and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of either **Uganda Shillings: Two hundred fifty thousand (UGX: 250,000/=)** or **United States Dollars: Seventy (USD70)** to the **Uganda National Oil Company Limited Account in Stanbic Bank Uganda Limited, Corporate Branch, Crested Towers on A/C No. 9030011896005 (Uganda Shillings) or 9030011896021 (US**

Dollars). Bidders should send an application letter and payment confirmation/receipt to: pl.unoc@unoc.com to obtain the Bidding document which shall be issued on email.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below at 8(a) at or before **10:00am** on **2nd April 2026**. All bids must be accompanied by a **Bid Security** of either **Ugx: 125,000,000/=** or **USD35,000** using the form indicated in the bidding forms. The Bid Security must be valid until **9th December 2026**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids shall be virtually opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend the online/virtual public bid opening session via Microsoft Teams Platform at **10:40am** on **2nd April 2026**. Bidders will be required to share email addresses of their representatives to attend the online/virtual public bid opening session prior to bid submission.
7. There shall be a virtual/online pre-bid meeting at **10:00am** on **13th March 2026** using the Microsoft Teams Platform. All interested eligible bidders are advised to include their email addresses in the Application letter (in 5 above) which UNOC will use to contact and invite them for the virtual online meeting.
